

Planting for Biodiversity

To get your balcony buzzing: Grow a range for plants for year-round flowering

Avoid plants with double or multi-petalled flowers

Do not use pesticides on plants in flower

If you have room, provide nest sites for solitary bees

Suggested plants for year-round flowering:

Spring Summer

Crocus Allium (ornamental onion)

Hellebores Cornflowers
Miniature daffodils Cosmos
Snowdrops Gaura

Hardy geraniums

Lavender Marigold Nemesia

Russian sage (Perovskia)

Salvias

Spotted dead nettle (lamium maculatum)

Verbena bonariensis

Autumn Winter

Asters (Michaelmas daisy) Clematis cirrhosa

Dahlias (single flowered)

Japanese anemone

Sedum

Crocus (winter-flowering types)

Eranthis hyemalis (winter aconite)

Galanthus nivalis (common snowdrop)

Plants to improve air quality Convolvulus cneorum (Silverbush)

Hebe "Mrs Winder" Heuchera villosa Lavender

Stachys Byzantina (Lambs ears - not all types flower)
